We have two aims

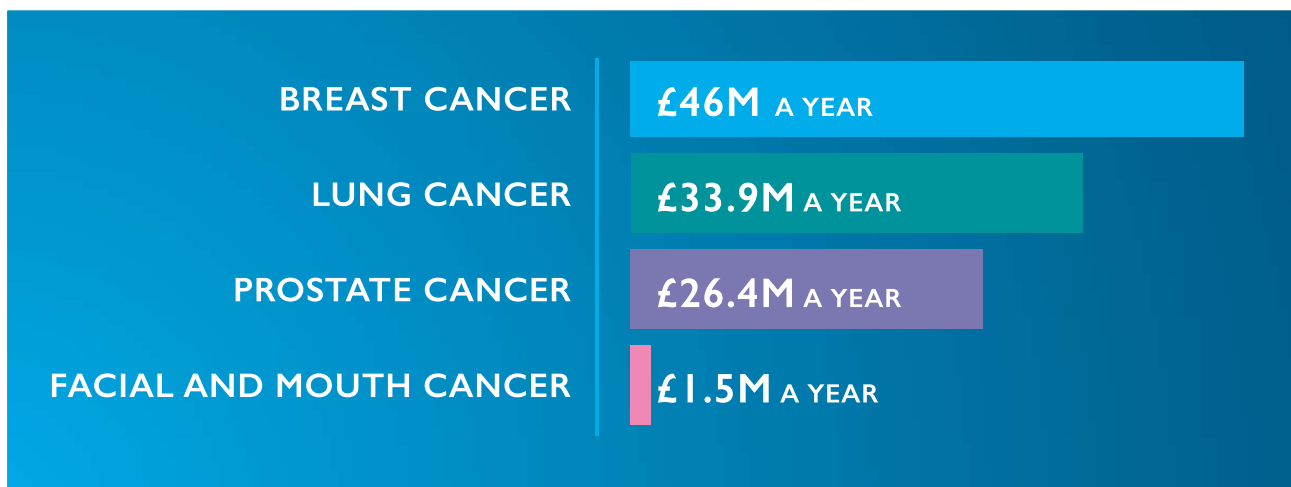
1. The Professor's research will improve the faces and lives of thousands of people around the world.
